

# 2023-2024 Verification Worksheet - Dependent Student

Your 2023–2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the Department of Education for a review in a process called verification. To ensure the information is correct, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet, and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected.

### **Verification of 2021 Income Information for Student Tax Filers**

To use the Get Transcript Online tool, the user must have (1) access to a valid email address, (2) a text-enabled mobile phone (pay-as-you-go plans cannot be used) in the user's name, and (3) specific financial account numbers (such as a credit card number or an account number for a home mortgage or auto loan). The transcript displays online upon successful completion of the IRS's two-step authentication.
- <u>Automated Telephone Request</u> 1-800-908-9946. Transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.
- <u>Paper Request Form</u> IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form.
